0.1 Before your session

Arrive with ease	Please plan to arrive around 10 minutes early. Comfortable shoes and layers that suit the season usually make the experience feel more relaxed.
Bring the practical things	Keep valuables and large bags light where possible. We recommend water in warm weather and an umbrella or light layer when rain is possible.
No posing experience needed	Your photographer gives simple, natural direction. The goal is to help you feel present in your trip rather than perform for the camera.

0.2 If the weather changes

Light rain can still create beautiful photographs and does not automatically cancel a session. If it is safe and comfortable, the route or pace may be adapted. Focus Japan does not proceed when weather or local conditions make the experience unsafe, including severe wind, lightning, alerts, closures, flooding, or unsafe travel. When a session cannot safely continue, the team will discuss a same-day adjustment, meaningful alternative, no-fee reschedule, or—when a comparable safe option cannot be offered during the trip—a full refund or future credit.

0.3 After the session

Private gallery	Your edited high-resolution photographs are normally delivered in a private online gallery within 5–7 business days, unless your confirmed booking says otherwise.
Share-ready files	Optional social-friendly downloads are available for the memories you would like to share. Posting is always your choice.
